**ORDER SCHEDULING FILING DEADLINES FOR OBJECTIONS TO
SPECIAL MASTER REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION NO. 2**

On November 3, 2014, the Special Master issued Special Master Report and Recommendation No. 2 [ECF No. 4080 in Case No. 96-01285 (TFH)] (referred to herein as “the Special Master’s decision”), which recommends the denial of specified appeals that were filed by individuals (“claimants”) challenging prior determinations that their claims failed to demonstrate eligibility to receive payments from the settlement funds established pursuant to the Settlement Agreement that was approved by the Court on July 27, 2011. This order schedules due dates for the filing of objections to the Special Master’s decision issued on November 3, 2014. Any objections to the Special Master’s decision must comply with the procedures discussed in the Standing Order Regarding Objections to the Special Master’s Decision (the “Standing Order”)

[ECF No. 4077 in Case No. 96-01285 (TFH)], which was issued by the Court on October 22, 2014. Accordingly, it hereby is


ORDERED that a claimant's memorandum of points and authorities objecting to the Special Master's decision shall be due to be filed on or before December 22, 2014. It further is

ORDERED that responses to a claimant's memorandum of points and authorities objecting to the Special Master's decision, if any, shall be due to be filed on or before January 9, 2015. It finally is

ORDERED that if a claimant wishes to file a reply brief in support of his or her memorandum of points of authorities objecting to the Special Master's decision, the reply brief shall be due to be filed on or before January 30, 2015.
